



2023 River City Showdown Iowa Select Facility Guidelines & Tournament Information

Parking at the QC VB Factory

- Facility Address: 2060 W River Dr., Davenport, Iowa
- Facility is located behind the Devon's Self Storage Building
 - Parking Access
 - You can enter the Devon's Self Storage Parking lot and drive to the left of the business to access the gym's parking lot.
 - You can access our side parking lot from Schmidt road (one turn away from the main entrance), which will lead you adjacent to the main parking lot. There is ramp access from that parking lot to enter the main facilities parking lot.
- Facility will open at 7:15AM, first matches will be played at 8am

Admission

- Unless noted differently in the Tournament Director's email, all admission costs are \$8 for everyone, children 10 and under are free.
- Coaches & rostered adults will be free. Rostered adults need to be on the event roster that was turned in for this weekend. There will be a list of rostered coaches and adults at our check-in table. It is the responsibility of your club director/coach/team rep to turn that roster into us.
 - **THERE IS NO OUTSIDE SEATING/LAWN CHAIRS ALLOWED IN THE FACILITY**
 - **THERE IS NO OUTSIDE COOLERS ALLOWED IN THE FACILITY**

Concessions

- There will be a full concession stand available inside of the facility. Please be considerate of those teams around you and pick up any trash that your team makes throughout the day. There will be healthy options available as well.

Pool Play and Bracket Play Format and Expectations of Coaches/Team Reps

- **SATURDAY DIVISIONS**
 - 13/14s Division (5 teams)
 - We will play the 5 team pool across 2 courts, if you are the ref team you are responsible for refing both courts.

- We will play 2 sets only to 25 points, NO CAP, during pool play matches
 - In bracket play, we will play best 2 out of 3 to 25 points, NO CAP, 3rd set played to 15 if needed. NO CAP during 3rd set play as well.
 - 15/16s Division (6 teams)
 - We will play 2 sets only to 25 points, NO CAP, during pool play matches
 - In bracket play, we will play best 2 out of 3 to 25 points, NO CAP, 3rd set played to 15 if needed. NO CAP during 3rd set play as well.
 - Pay attention to play assignments in bracket play, as we will play out the 3rd place and 5th place tiebreakers so each team is getting an appropriate amount of matches for the day.
- **SUNDAY DIVISION - 17/18s (11 teams)**
 - We will play 2 sets only to 25 points, NO CAP, during pool play matches
 - Teams in the 3-team pool will play ALL 3 sets to 25 to make up for no 4th team in their pool, with NO CAP.
 - In bracket play, we will play best 2 out of 3 to 25 points, NO CAP, 3rd set played to 15 if needed. NO CAP during 3rd set play as well.
 - The top 6 finishers will play in a Gold Bracket and the bottom 5 finishers will play in the silver bracket.
- We will supply Line-Up sheets for coaches and all necessary reffing forms needed to ref. Adults should be the up-refs for the entirety of the tournament.
- Warm-Up times:
 - Each teams 1st match of the day: 2-4-4 (2 shared, 4 serving team, 4 receiving team)
 - All matches after: 1-3-3
 - We will play ahead as much as possible, if there is an opportunity to move matches onto a different court to speed up pool or bracket play, we will look to do so as long as both teams are willing and there is a ref team who can help ref.
- **Coaches & Team Reps**
 - Please supply your own volleyballs for warm-ups and do not ball handle near those who are sitting and watching another game.
 - Please make sure your families and fans are cheering appropriately, not yelling at line-judges or work teams, and helping maintain a positive and healthy environment. There will be 0 tolerance with unruly fans, they will be asked to leave the facility.
 - Please ask your players to clean their benches when they finish playing their matches.
 - Keep an eye on the schedule, if there are opportunities to play ahead, we would like to do so.
 - If your team loses during bracket play, there is a high chance you will have to ref, please don't leave if your team has to ref or play a tiebreaker match. If you're not sure, just ask the Tournament Director if your team can leave or not. In situations

where 2 teams have to share ref, it is common and a great gesture that the local team will ref the full match.
